



BNA Switchgear Upgrade Phase 1



Harlan Electric Company, Inc. completed Phase 1 of a total switchgear upgrade to the Nashville International Airport. Work included removal of old gear and replacement with new switchgear. Shutdowns were scheduled during non-peak hours. Nashville International Airport is served by 10 airlines and three cargo carriers. There are 392 average daily arriving and departing flights, operating from 45 air carrier gates. Nashville International provides nonstop and air service to nearly 49 markets in the U.S., Canada, and Mexico. The airport serves nearly 10 million passengers annually.
